Terms and Conditions for Passive Fire Protection Inspections

1. Definitions

- * "Company" refers to Fire Protection Inspections Ltd, a company registered in England.
- * "Client" refers to the individual or organization contracting the Company's services.
- * "Inspection" refers to the passive fire protection inspection maintenance services

 Level 1 and Level 2 provided by the Company.
- * "Property" refers to the building or premises where the inspection is conducted.
- * "Report" refers to the written documentation of the inspection findings.

2. Scope of Services

- * The Company will conduct a visual inspection of the accessible passive fire protection systems at the Property, as detailed in the agreed-upon scope of work. This may include fire stopping, compartmentation, and other passive fire protection measures.
- * The Inspection is limited to readily accessible areas and visible defects at the time of the inspection. Concealed or inaccessible areas are excluded unless specifically agreed upon in writing.
- * The Company will provide a written Report detailing the inspection findings as outlined in the Inspection Packages document.
- * This agreement does not cover any remedial work or repairs these will be assigned to the original installation company or a company named by the client.

3. Client Responsibilities

- * The Client is responsible for providing the Company with access to all areas of the Property relevant to the inspection.
- * Depending on the chosen package The Client shall provide any relevant documentation as outlined in the Inspections Package document and confirmed in the Responsible Person's Check List.
- * The Client is responsible for ensuring the safety of the Company's personnel whilst on the Property.

4. Company Responsibilities

- * The Company will conduct the Inspection in a professional and workmanlike manner, in accordance with industry best practices and relevant regulations.
- * The Company will provide the Client with a clear and concise Report of the inspection findings in-line with the chosen package
- * The Company will maintain appropriate insurance coverage.

5. Fees and Payment

- * The Client agrees to pay the Company the fees specified in the agreed-upon quotation or contract.
- * Payment is due inline with Fire Protection Inspections Ltd payment policy.
- * The Company reserves the right to charge interest on overdue payments.

6. Liability

- * The Company's liability for any errors or omissions in the Inspection Report shall be limited to the amount of the inspection fee.
- * The Company shall not be liable for any consequential loss or damage arising from the Inspection or the Report.
- * This limitation of liability does not apply to any liability arising from the Company's negligence or willful default.

7. Confidentiality

* The Company will treat all information relating to the Client and the Property as confidential.

8. Governing Law

* These terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the construction laws of England and Wales

9. Entire Agreement

* These terms and conditions, together with the agreed-upon scope of work and quotation/contract, constitute the entire agreement between the Company and the Client relating to the Inspection.

10. Force Majeure

* Neither party shall be liable for any failure or delay in performing its obligations under this agreement to the extent that such failure or delay is caused by a force majeure event, such as natural disasters, acts of terrorism, or government actions.

12. Dispute Resolution

* Any disputes arising under or in connection with these terms and conditions shall be resolved through construction arbitration process.

13. Amendments

* These terms and conditions may be amended by the Company from time to time. The Client will be notified of any changes.
